



## **CAMPGROUND REGULATIONS**

Please read these rules.

During the 2018 WMMP Racing Season the privilege of camping at the White Mountain Motorsports Park grass area out back will have a donation of \$10.00 per night or \$400.00 for the race season per vehicle. This money collected will go towards the mowing of grass, rubbish removal, toilets, and water. Town water is available on the left after you turn to enter the field, which will not be on during weekdays or night time. No waste liquids of any kind may be discharged at any time. There is a rubbish container down by the office.

There are a few SIMPLE RULES we must enforce:

1. There will be no ATVs of any kind allowed.
2. All generators must be turned off by 11 PM even on race night & must not be started before 7 AM.
3. Fires must be kept under control and contained within a maximum of a 24" diameter border. Fires must be on their way out by 2:00 AM. All fires must be put out when leaving the camping area. Do not leave fires unattended.
4. Parties and loud noise must be kept under control. We appreciate respect for others on this matter.
5. NO FIREWORKS ANYTIME.
6. Dogs must be tied up, and their messes must be cleaned up.
7. Self-contained campers only.
8. Please keep your campsite clean and orderly at all times. When the season is over and it's time to leave, don't leave your junk behind for us.
9. Kids on bikes must stay down at the campground on race days. NO riding bikes after dark.
10. Do not go on the property that connects to the campground!! Stay on the campground area.
11. All vehicles and campers must be removed by October 8, 2018.
12. This campground is for Race Teams and Spectators only. If you chose not to attend the race, then please find a different place to camp.
13. If we feel at any time that your site is giving us too much trouble or your visitors are giving us too much trouble, we will ask you to leave and you won't be allowed to camp at WMMP for the rest of the race season.
14. At the end of the season you must pick up the mess at your site.
