



## 2024 WMMP CAMPGROUND REGULATIONS

**We are NOT a licensed NH Campground and cannot allow people to stay on site during the week.**

During the 2023 White Mountain Motorsports Park racing season, camping in the designated area's fee will be \$25 for one night, \$40 for two nights or \$475 for the Racing Season per vehicle. The seasonal fee after 4/5/24 is 600.00 and after 8/1/24 is 300.00.

Town water is available on the left after you turn to enter the field. It is not on during weekdays or after dark.

**No waste liquids** of any kind may be discharged at any time, there are 2 dump stations that can be used.

You must take your trash with you as there is **no pickup**. There are 2 dumpsters next to the office to dispose of your camping trash. Break down any cardboard before placing it in the container. Large items, such as grills, must be taken with you and **not** put into dumpsters.

**\*\*NOTE: Campers who have not registered for full-season camping MUST remove their vehicles following each race weekend. Those who repeatedly leave their vehicles in the camping area during the week will be considered full-season campers and charged accordingly.**

### **There are some RULES we must enforce:**

1. Self-contained campers only. Tents are NOT PERMITTED.
2. Dogs must be on a leash and their messes be cleaned up.
3. ATVs, of any kind, are not allowed.
4. Golf karts are allowed but only those **18+** are permitted to operate on any WMMP property – This also applies to any motorized vehicle including, but not limited to, scooters, bikes, etc.

NOTE: Everyone needs to drive their kart safely and be respectful of others as they are a privilege. Anyone on a kart MUST be seated and recklessness will not be tolerated. Personal golf karts are not allowed in the pit area.

- a. Again, Reckless Operation will not be tolerated. Individuals will get one warning concerning speed and/or reckless operation of any motorized vehicle. Should a second discussion be needed, the offender will not be allowed to bring any motorized vehicle into the campground and will have to park in the upper lot.
5. Inflatable pools are **not** permitted.
  6. Kids on bikes must remain in the camping area on race days. Bike riding is not permitted after dusk.
  7. Do not go onto the property that connects to the camping area. It is private property and we do not have permission to access; stay within the camping area.
  8. This campground is for race teams/spectators only. If you do not attend the races, please find another place to camp.
  9. **Quiet hours are 11:00 pm – 7:00 am.** This will be enforced.
    - a. **All generators must be turned off by 11 PM even on a race night & may not be started before 7 AM.**
    - b. No outside overhead lights are permitted. This includes lights on poles, outside of awnings or outside of campers (unless factory installed.)
    - c. Gatherings and loud noise must be kept under control. We appreciate your respect for others on this matter. If the town decides we need to hire security to take care of the problem, we will need to charge an additional fee to pay for the additional expense incurred by the camping area.

#### **d. Per the Woodstock Police Department DISORDERLY ACTIONS ORDINANCE ( Noise Complaints)**

The penalty for a violation of this ordinance shall be a fine of \$100.00 for a first offense. For any second violation within a 12-month period the fine shall be \$250.00. For any third or subsequent violation within a 12-month period the fine shall be \$500.00. Failure to remit the fine within 5 days may result in the issuance of a summons and added fines.

- e. Fires must be kept under control and contained within a maximum of a 24" diameter border. Fires must be on their way out by 2:00 AM. All fires must be put out when leaving the camping area. Do not leave fires unattended.

f. No outside overhead lights are permitted. This includes lights on poles, outside of awnings or outside of campers (unless factory installed.)

g. **NO FIREWORKS ANYTIME.**

h. In conjunction with Quiet Hours, Golf Carts may not be operated after 11pm.

**NOTE:** If we feel that at any time that your site is giving us too much trouble, this includes any visitors that you may have as you are responsible, we will ask you to leave. You will not be allowed to camp at WMMP for the rest of the race season and no refunds will be issued.

10. Please keep your area clean/orderly. At the end of the season, **which is October 14, 2024**, all vehicles and campers must be removed, and your area must be picked up. If we have to clean up any trash left behind, you will be billed accordingly.
