



## **WMMP FACE MASK POLICIES PER NEW HAMPSHIRE EXECUTIVE ORDER**

Beginning at the Saturday, August 15 event, White Mountain Motorsports Park asks that all attendees comply with the New Hampshire state executive order issued on August 11 regarding face masks and/or facial coverings. This includes fans, drivers, crew members, staff, officials, and all others who attend, race, or work at White Mountain Motorsports Park.

The executive order mandates that face masks/coverings be worn at scheduled public or private social, recreational, and spiritual gatherings with 100 or more people. Exceptions are made for when attendees are seated or otherwise separated by at least six feet from those outside their household/group. Children under the age of 2 years old also do not have to wear a mask.

In accordance with the executive order, White Mountain Motorsports Park asks that all attendees wear a face mask when moving around the property outside their seat or pit area.

Examples include:

- Exiting and entering the facility.
- Purchasing grandstand tickets at the ticket booth or signing in at the pit gate.
- Going to the concessions and/or bathrooms.
- Walking around the main grandstands or outside your pit area.
- Interacting with track staff and others outside your team/household/group.

The following are times when attendees do NOT have to wear a face mask:

- When spectators are in their seats and able to physically distance from those outside their household/group.
- When team members are in their specific pit area with their own group.
- Drivers who are in their cars.
- When someone is eating or drinking.
